How to participate?

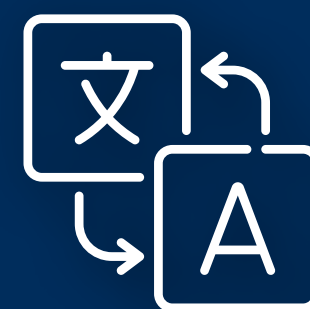

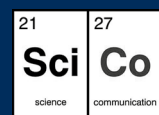
